

## Hunting, Fishing, and Trapping Fees

### Issue

List the various hunting, fishing, and trapping licenses, permits, stamps, and other credentials available to Connecticut residents and the associated fees for each under state law.

### Summary

Table 1 identifies, by citation, the hunting, fishing, and trapping credentials available to Connecticut residents (individuals and entities) and the fees charged for them under state law. It excludes fees charged to nonresidents for similar credentials. The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) provides additional information, including fees that it sets, on its webpages for [Hunting and Trapping](#) and [Fishing](#).
